Dear Millikin Parents/Guardians:

It is the District's policy to provide a free appropriate public education to all students with disabilities in conformance with the provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 in all of its schools, including Millikin. This means that modifications, supplementary aids and services in the regular education program and/or special education services will be provided to any qualified student with a disability, where necessary and appropriate to meet the student's individual needs.

The District has a responsibility to conduct an evaluation of any student who needs or is believed to need special education or related services due to a disability. If there is a disagreement regarding the need for an evaluation, the disagreement is subject to due process hearing procedures. Any parent who believes his or her child needs special education or related services due to a disability may request an evaluation of the student.

Parents or guardians of students believed to be in need of special education or related services, based on a disability, are entitled to due process protections with regard to any action concerning identification, evaluation or placement of a student with a disability. These procedural rights include the right to request a hearing if the parent disagrees with a decision concerning: (1) whether to evaluate a student; (2) the student's eligibility under the IDEA or Section 504 or (3) the placement or services that will be provided for the student.
